<u>Blue – Fidelity –</u> Participate and attend a Family Event such as a Reunion, Anniversary or Special Holiday by helping with the Planning and Preparation.

<u>Indigo - Patriotism -</u> Assist the Legion, Legion Auxiliary or other Military Service Organization with Projects of their choice, such as aid to Military Families.
