APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

To be considered for this scholarship grant provided through the Humanitarian Foundation of the Grottoes of North America, please read the following instructions carefully:

1. You must be an active member of the International Order of the Rainbow for Girls and a student in good standing with recommendations attesting to your worthiness to receive this grant. Majority member applicants must be no more than 23 years of age and must have been active in her Assembly and/or Grand Assembly for at least three (3) years before reaching Majority age.
2. This scholarship is available to deserving Rainbow Girls who are pursuing their post-high school education in a dental or medical field, preferably with some training in the area of service to persons with special needs.
3. This application must be completed in full, be neat and legible (preferably typed).
4. This is a one-time grant of \$500.00. Preference is given to those whose GPA is 3.0 or above.
5. Two personal references must be from people of respected standing in their respective communities who are not related to you in any way, preferably with Masonic affiliation. They must have or have had direct contact with and observation of your Rainbow and/or community activities. The letters should be sent directly to the Supreme Recorder by the authors.
6. Be certain all addresses and telephone numbers provided are complete, accurate, neat, and legible (typewritten is preferred).
7. The completed application and personal references must be received by the Supreme Recorder no later than **August 1, 2007** to be considered.
8. Provide a copy of your most recent transcript.
